We are currently developing a new project with deep cultural and community value: the **first art gallery in Texas specifically designed for children.**

Located in **Del Rio, Texas**, this gallery will be a dedicated space where children can engage with art through curiosity, play, and hands-on experiences. It is not simply about exhibiting artworks, but about **creating an environment where young visitors can experience art in a direct and meaningful way.**

In this space, children will be able to:

- **Explore art freely and with imagination**
- **Participate in workshops led by artists and educators**

The building is already under construction, and our goal is to open its doors to children and families in the near future.

We firmly believe that **introducing art early in life not only enriches education but also strengthens empathy, self-esteem, and a sense of belonging.** This initiative is envisioned as an **accessible, inclusive, and sustainable model** that will serve future generations for years to come.
